CLUB HISTORY

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Merewether Carlton is the most successful club in the Newcastle competition.

Merewether Carlton was formed in 1930 from the amalgamation of Cooks Hill Carlton and Cooks Hill Surf club. Cooks Hill Carlton was established in 1887.

For two years the jersey was sky blue with a Waratah emblem until the NSWRU requested a change. Bottle Green was then chosen.

The club won six 1st Grade Premierships between 1930 and 1940 and sixteen first XV Grade Premierships to date – the last being in the 2007 season.

The club has been Club Champions on nineteen occasions in its long history, a record that no other club has surpassed. This includes being club champions in the last five consecutive seasons – 2005 to 2009.

The club proudly fills the maximum number of teams possible in the Newcastle Competition comprising of five senior grades, a colts and a women's side. The club boasts approximately 200 registered players.
